


**Natural Colors**

Comment by the juries : Families of elephants, birds, dragonflies, and snails, creatures we all know well, are vividly depicted. The painting conveys very well the desire and kindness to protect the environment together with us humans.



#### The End of the Desert: Machines and Nature

Thoughts and wishes regarding the painting : This painting depicts a scene in which a robot leopard is chasing a rabbit. I imagined that the Earth would be very dry in the future and many wild animals will go extinct. I hope this painting inspires people to focus on protecting the environment.

Comment by the juries : Amazing painting! A sci-fi scenery portraying possibly Earth after Catastrophe, represented by landscape and bionic animals; perhaps this is how the sustainable future will look if we are not taking action right now. Instead of depicting a beautiful scene, this work critiques our perspective on sustainable living.



#### Taking Care of a Bamboo Forest in Mu Cang Chai, Yen Bai Province

Thoughts and wishes regarding the painting : Bamboo is extremely resilient against climate change as it can absorb up to three times as much carbon gas as other trees do. Bamboo forests reduce carbon emissions and bring economic gain. So let's take care of the bamboo forests in our town more proactively.

The activities around and within the forest - Seeding, Breeding, and Cultivating - require the participation of the whole community and invite engagement from all members across generations. THE FOREST



The sun, sky, clouds, and dragonflies are well balanced, and the depiction of the dragonfly's wings is especially exquisite.

#### **The Power of Seedlings**

Thoughts and wishes regarding the painting : Monkeys and owls are losing their homes because people are cutting down trees. Now, they are cold because the wind blows on them. We need to stop cutting trees so the animals can stay warm and safe.

Jury Kei Matsushita Selected The forest like the narrative with the owl at the center is depicted from a critical perspective. Elements with individual meanings, such as clouds, trees, wind, and leaves, are combined like a collage, and as the result of the fusion, it seems that we can read a story finding hope for the future.

Thoughts and wishes regarding the painting : Small seedlings become one by human hands, becoming a powerful force. Just like a big tree that provides shade and spreads its branches, bringing blessings to living things and the environment.

Jury Andreas Schneider Selected The painting uses a simple graphic technique to illustrate the role of countless people in sowing - the source of all living things. Holding the young saplings in both hands, close to the heart, is a powerful representation of people's devotion to the perpetual cycle of life. This is a call we can only heed.





#### Connecting to the future through reading books

Thoughts and wishes regarding the painting: I drew some plants and animals that I had grown to love while reading books. Thoughts and wishes regarding the painting: I got inspiration from a banner. It was the first thing that popped into my mind when I saw the banner. I wish that we can change the way we're living, to a world where the nature is preserved well.

Jury Atsushi Tanaka Selected Water, a resource, is squeezed out of the hands of children holding each other's hands and the hands of action to take care of the earth. The message that an abundant environment is provided from this process is expressed in an understandable way and reaches to the viewer's hearts.



#### **Boarding the Ship of Hope**

Thoughts and wishes regarding the painting : We must try hard to protect the environment of only one Earth together.
