Kao Group Occupational Health and Safety Policy

Philosophy

The management will take leadership to create a safe, healthy and conformable work environment by paying attention to the safety and health of all people working in each site of the Kao Group.

Basic Policy

- 1. We will develop health, safety, security and disaster prevention activities through consultation with and participation by workers to create a health, comfortable and safe work environment.
- 2. We will set and regularly review the "safety, health, security and disaster prevention" goals and make efforts to achieve the goals.
- 3. We will comply with each county's laws and regulations related to health and safety, internal regulations and other requirements to improve the level of management.
- 4. We will reduce risks by implementing risk assessment related to the "safety, health, security and disaster prevention" to prevent industrial and other accidents.
- 5. We will make efforts to share and standardize preventive and safety measures and enhance the maintenance of facilities by collecting information on external and internal accidents.
- 6. We will continuously improve the occupational health and safety management system and conduct self-inspection and audit to maintain the effectiveness.
- 7. We will make efforts to improve the health of workers and create and promote a comfortable work environment.
- 8. We will announce this policy to all persons who work in the Kao Group and promote occupational health and safety education. In addition, we will publish this policy externally.
- 9. We will use appropriate management resources to implement this policy and effectively and continuously improve it.
